## HARRIET BOUSLOG LABOR SCHOLARSHIP

# DEADLINE EXTENDED TO APRIL 1, 2016

*If you are an ILWU member or retiree and have a relative (need not be a child or grandchild) who plans to attend a University of Hawaii campus or is already attending, please encourage these students to apply for the Harriet Bouslog Labor Scholarship.*

*The scholarship is made available through the generosity of the late Harriet Bouslog, a longtime attorney for the ILWU, and her late husband, Stephen Sawyer, who set up a trust fund to provide scholarships to ILWU children and grandchildren. Since 1989, the Harriet Bouslog Labor Scholarship has awarded scholarships to more than 200 ILWU students.*



### **Here are the requirements to apply:**

- Must be related to an active or retired ILWU member. ILWU members may also apply.
- Must be planning to attend or already attending the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Hilo or West Oahu, or any of the seven community colleges. Students must carry a minimum of 12 credits per semester.
- Must complete an application, write a short essay, and videotape an interview with an ILWU member or retiree.
- May be a high school senior entering UH as a freshman or a UH student at one of the 10 campuses. (Note: Preference is given to high school seniors.) Scholarships may also be available for graduate studies.

The Harriet Bouslog Labor Scholarship Fund awards up to 10 new scholarships each year. The awards are: \$2,000 per semester for UH Manoa; \$1,000 per semester for UH Hilo or UH West Oahu; and \$750 per semester for community college. Scholarships may be renewed each semester for up to eight semesters for students in a baccalaureate program.
